- At the May ANSTF meeting, the Department of the Interior and National Invasive Species Council presented an overview of an effort to work with Federal agencies, states, and tribes to develop a framework for a national Early Detection and Rapid Response (EDRR) program and emergency response fund.
- The Framework was called for by the White House Council on Climate Preparedness and Resilience.
- DOI and NISC are co-chairing this initiative and invited ANSTF members to participate in either a Federal EDRR Work Group or Non-Federal EDRR Advisory Team.
- They also requested information on existing EDRR plans and networks as well as input on EDRR needs and opportunities.
- The Work Group and Advisory Team convened throughout the summer and drafted components of the Framework.
- This presentation will provide an update on the progress and status of the final report of recommendations.
